



## INVITATION TO THE PRESS CONFERENCE FOR PRESENTING THE EUROPEAN PROJECT "I-SEE"

for strengthening information exchange between Italy and South East Europe neighboring countries on New Psychoactive Substances

All media are invited to participate to the press conference organized by the National Institute of Public Health Slovenia, in collaboration with the University of Florence (Italy), on February 22<sup>nd</sup> 2016, which will be held at National Institute of Public Health Slovenia, Trubarjeva cesta 2, 1000 Ljubljana, Slovenia, at 11.00 am.

The spread of New Psychoactive Substances (NPS) in Europe and worldwide is an increasing emergency for consumers' health. As a result, there is a more and more urgent need to identify new integrated forms of prevention, intervention and accurate monitoring. One of those tools is the new **European project I-SEE**, project for strengthening information exchange on NPS between Italy and South East Europe neighboring countries. The project and its first results will be presented during the press conference.

The project is granted by the European Commission and involves 5 partners: from Italy, the University of Florence, as coordinator; from Slovenia, the National Institute of Public Health, the Ministry of Interior Police and the Association DrogArt; from Croatia, the University of Split School of Medicine.

<u>Project's main objectives, activities, results and benefits</u> for the whole European Community will be introduced and a new international tool to tackle the phenomenon of New Psychoactive Substances internationally spreading will be described.
