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


Slovenian Early Warning System on NPS

 2005 - first model of Slovenian EWS established, upgraded later.



- 2007 the EWS is adopted at national level by Ministry of Health. Coordination of NEWS under NIJZ.
- 2014 regional expansion started.







I-SEE Slovenia: What do we want to achieve?



to build up regional networks involving law enforcement, NGO's and public health professionals



to detect NPS in an early phase of their appearance and in regions where they are entering the country



to enable anonymous collection of NPS samples in regions



to speed up the procedure of anonymous collection of NPS samples and their analysis



to speed up the response in terms of informing the users and take adequate measures to tackle the problem





I-SEE Slovenia: How will we achieve it?

organize trainings for public health experts, NGO's and the Police

prepare guidelines for collecting and anonymously seizing NPS samples

set up NGO focal points: to collect NPS samples and provide counselling

set up Police focal points: to anonymously seize collected samples of NPS and send them to analysis to NFL

building up a network of public health experts on NPS: to provide clinical information on NPS and implement adequate measures

set up a national base of NPS
